Program Description

- Students will gain skills in various aspects of the pipe trades – plumbing, steamfitting/pipefitting/gasfitting, sprinkler fitting and B - pressure welding
- Earn industry credentials in fall protection and confined space
- Training takes place in an industry setting by Journeyperson instructors

Student Eligibility

Open to CESD high school students, who are/have:

- Minimum 16 years of age
- Successfully completed TEC 1000 and/or WLD 1167 at Olds College
- On track for high school graduation and are recommended by their school for their strong efforts in current high school courses
- Have completed at a minimum English 20-2, Math 20-3 and Science 10
- Students must have completed these 3 trainings HCS 3000, HCS 3010 and Construction Safety Training Systems [CSTS] (available through your high school off-campus coordinator)
- Mature, punctual and reliable with a strong work ethic and willingness to learn
- Able to commit to the duration of the program and attend training Monday to Thursday from 9:00-12:00 or 1:00 to 4:00 for 16 weeks.
- Have transportation to the training site in Innisfail
- CSA approved steel-toed boots – all other PPE supplied

- Training by qualified Piping Industry Training School Journeyperson instructors to learn about the various pipe trades at no cost to students
- Explore the possibility of careers related to the pipe trades
- Earn up to 10 credits towards completion of your Alberta High School Diploma
