Automotive Service Technician

Automotive Service Technician Apprenticeship - 4 years

As an Automotive Service Technician, you will maintain, diagnose and repair automotive vehicles, cars and light trucks. Automotive Service Technicians are employed by automotive repair shops, specialty repair shops, service facilities, car/truck dealerships and large organizations.

Academic Requirements

Apprenticeship and Industry Training (AIT) entrance recommended path requirements:

- ELA 30-2
- Math 30-3
- Physics 30 or Chem 30 or Science 30
- Related CTS courses

Minimum Requirements:

- ELA 20-2
- Math 20-3
- Science 10

Admission Requirements

How to become an Apprentice:

1. Ensure you meet Apprenticeship and Industry Training (AIT) eligibility and entrance requirements for your desired skilled trade.
2. Find a sponsor/employer to begin earning on-the-job hours towards your apprenticeship.
