About This Course

Students must be in grade 11 or 12 to enroll. To utilize this course towards a nursing program the minimum grade required is 75% and must be completed within two years of entry to the nursing program. Students will have completed Bio 30 before taking this course and be a strong academic student in good standing.

If you want to learn more about the different structures and functions within the human body and are interested in potentially pursuing a career in nursing, this course may be a good fit for you! This course can be used towards the completion of a Practical Nurse Diploma, or a Bachelor of Science in Nursing Collaboration with the University of Alberta.

Course Description

NURS 215 is an introductory human anatomy course. It will provide students with an understanding of the normal structure of the human body, how this structure provides the basis for the function and how this may be disrupted during the diseased state.
